## Professional Learning And Teacher Standards

The King's School continued to focus on delivering quality professional learning to its teaching community and driving their ongoing attention to the AITSL Professional Standards in 2020. However, unlike any other year, the ability to attend face to face training was hampered by the COVID-19 lockdown and restrictions. Interstate and international travel grinded to a halt and we saw a large number of upskilling opportunities cancelled. Many providers had to learn to adapt rapidly to change methods of delivery and offer new course content. While this was a challenge, it also brought a rich learning environment in many teaching spaces, especially in learning technology.

We also have many teachers that contribute to the many focussed professional learning communities throughout the School, whether they be in departments, across departments or as a whole School community across all three campuses.

Across the The King's School in 2020, 12 teachers were Conditionally accredited, of whom seven gained Proficient Teacher Accreditation during the course of the year. The Professional Practice and Accreditation Leader and their relevant Head of Department (Senior School staff) or Deputy Head - Academics (Preparatory School) supported teachers undergoing their Proficient Teacher Accreditation.

In November 2020, all schools and professional learning providers across NSW had their NESA endorsement to provide accredited professional learning cancelled by the Minister of Education and Early Childhood Learning. This decision has serious implications for The King's Institute's (the professional learning authority within The King's School) ability to provide teachers at the School with sufficient accredited professional development hours. Full time Teachers are still required to do 100 hours of professional development over five years (seven years for PT) to maintain their accreditation. However, the 50 hours of NESA accredited courses must now be undertaken in priority areas that adhere to stringent principles of effective PD, while courses in the other 50 hours will need to meet a set list of elective principles.

Throughout 2020, The King's Institute facilitated the following courses via multi campus professional learning days and individual campus professional learning days. These activities included:

- Family Zone Cyber Safety
- Halloran Morrissey Update on Royal Commission findings, and the National Principal for Child Safe Organisations
- Associate Professor Matt Bower Learning Technologies in Practice (Micro credentialed modules though Macquarie University's Master of Education program)
- Halloran Morrissey Child Safe Organisations and Reporting Obligations
- Dr Dean Dudley Learning Technologies in Practice (Ongoing tutoring)
- Canvas @ King's Introductory Canvas Course
- Shannon O'Dwyer Analysing the POI
- Priority Manager Your Time Matters
- Dr Danielle Einstein Chilled and Considerate Program

The King's Institute also facilitated the LeadCOMM seminar series. LeadCOMM is a professional learning program designed to develop leadership excellence and the capabilities for teaching and non-teaching leaders who have the responsibility of leading and managing staff at The King's School. LeadCOMM commenced 2020 with a workshop facilitated by the AIS NSW titled 'Brave and Faithful Conversations'.

Staff across all three campuses also undertook a number of compliance training activities in 2020. These included

- the majority of teaching staff completing CPR and PFA (Inclusive of Anaphylaxis and Asthma). This was a challenge in 2020 due to COVID-19 restrictions with face to face training and the use of CPR mannequins. All staff were able to make up sessions once COVID restrictions eased.
- 14 staff completed Remote Wilderness Training
- staff with responsibilities as outlined in the Emergency Management Plan received bi-annual Warden training
- 93 staff completed Swim Teacher Rescue Training.

The King's Institute also hosted a Research Symposium for staff in Term 4 of 2020. The event was well attended with presentations from a member of the School Council, several teaching staff who were undertaking postgraduate studies, research students involved in projects associated with The King's Institute, and external academics researching topics of interest to the School.
